REDMOND HISTORIC LANDMARKS INVENTORY

Below is a list of designated Historic Landmarks in the City of Redmond approved by the City Council and adopted as part of Redmond's Comprehensive Plan. The inventory identifies buildings or sites of historical importance or architectural significance that are considered exemplary of their time and style. Any exterior modification to these historic structures must be reviewed and approved by the Redmond Historical Landmarks Commission. There are twenty (20) designated historical landmarks, three of which are listed on the National Register of Historic Places: the Milton Odem House (built in 1937), the New Redmond Hotel (built in 1928), and the Presbyterian Community Church (built in 1912).
