Affordable Housing Task Force

- Role
 - Review input from community meetings & focus groups
 - Study & identify affordable housing strategies and policies
 - Make recommendations to City Council

Benefits of a Task Force

- Task force would represent a broad cross-section of community ensuring a variety of perspectives
- Working group can sift through existing research and input to identify strategies that best serve the city
- Task force work is transparent and open to the public

Moving Forward with a Task Force

- 9 members representing affordable housing advocates, businesses, residents, developers, etc.
- Lay out a work plan and timeline
- Hold regularly scheduled meetings that are open to the public

Next Steps

- If City Council decides to proceed with task force, next steps include:
 - Appoint members to task force
 - Hold City Council work session to define goals and other parameters for task force
